# Product Enhancements

## 1.1 FIPPA: Statistical Report Subsection View

ID# 99736

The subsections of section 8 in the FIPPA Statistical Report are now displayed in the report in accordance with the FIPPA workbook.

## 1.2 FIPPA: Processed Days Calculation

ID# 100705

The Processed Days amount is determined when a user performs Final Actions on a request. This amount is calculated using the Disposition Accepted date, rather than the Closed Date.

## 1.3 Custom Requests Report Filter: Disposition Accepted Date

ID# 101798

We've added a *Disposition Accepted Date* filter to the Custom Requests Report.

## 1.4 New Configuration: Lock Consultation Access Based on Action Office

ID# 103396

We've added a setting in Document Management Configuration to *Restrict user search/view access to consultations only created by users in the same action office*. Enabling this configuration allows users to only be able to search/view consultations created by the Action Office in which they are associated within the application.



## Bug Fixes

We've addressed the following bugs in this version of ATIPXpress:

ID	Description
98304	Updated the sequence number assignment process. After a request is deleted, its sequence number can be reused for another request of the same type without causing a timeout error.
101797	Fixed a bug where the FIPPA Statistical Report was incorrectly counting requests in the Recycle Bin. The Statistical Report now displays the correct request counts and excludes requests in the Recycle Bin.
