

We've added a date field to the Persons section of the main case tab to indicate when the subject was notified. The field can be relabeled via *Configuration*.

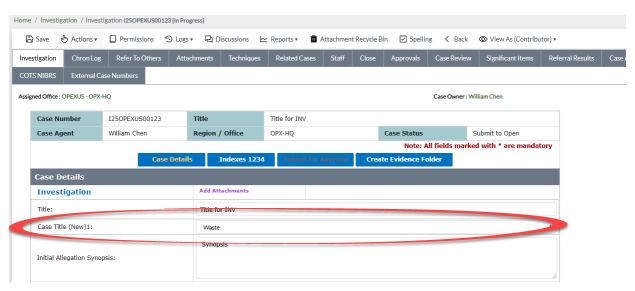
1.2 Multi-Line Text for External Complaint Tracking Number Field
