ID	Feature	Description
52320	Delegate to Me Workflow	Users can now click Delegate to Me before completing required fields on a <i>Complaints</i> form. This action was possible in previous versions of the application and has been reinstated for ease of use.

Bug Fixes

The following bug fixes were applied in the latest version of eCASE Investigations:

33803	Addressed a bug preventing Assistance Request entries in the <i>Assistance</i> tab from deleting properly.
48939	Removed an incorrect error message appearing on the NIBRIS tab when submitting NIBRIS Offenses for review.
49179	Attachment quantity now accurately updates on the <i>Techniques</i> tab and <i>Related Cases</i> workflow when a document is deleted.
52476	Users can now save updates to Case Closing Checklist answers before submitting. This allows users to fill out partial data, save the incomplete form, then return later to complete remaining fields and submit the form.

52915	Corrected a bug where, when reopening a closed Complaint case, the system automatically and incorrectly assigned the user who reopened the case as a second Lead Agent.
