




Print Filtered Inventory & Evidence Reports

Evidence Field Configuration Updates

ID# 83994, 83998, 83999

We've added new fields to the *Evidence Field Configuration* tab in Configuration to enhance the *Create New Evidence Item* form.



- Room Number
- Warrant Number
- Bar Code
- Location Personnel (First Name, Last Name/Agency)
- Seizing Agent (First Name, Last Name/Agency)
- Seized From Owner/Other

These fields can be shown/hidden and made required in Configuration. We've also included the existing Seized From (Name/Agency/Company/Address/Phone Number) and Item Description / Noticeable Damage fields to Configuration so they can be enabled/disabled as needed.
