

New Features

The following new features were added to the latest eCASE Investigations release:

ID	Feature	Description
23973	Removed Automatic Due Date	Removed auto-generated date that appears under the "Date Allegation Received" field which indicates a date 30 days after the date in the "Date Logged" field.
24945	Automatically Add Evidence to Inventory	All evidence items added to an evidence case folder are also automatically added to the list of evidence items within the "Inventory" tab of that folder. All "Filter Data" options within the "Evidence" tab have also been added to the "Inventory" tab.
25415	Added Cleared Exceptionally Field	On the Arrest Questionnaire, added a new "Cleared Exceptionally" Field below "County of Arrest" with the following selections: "Death of Offender," "Prosecution Declined," "In Custody of Other Jurisdiction," "Victim Refused to Cooperate," "Juvenile/No Custody," and "Not Applicable."
25450	Offense Name List Item Ordering	In the NIBRIS "Offense Name" options list, we reversed the order of the list items to display the offense name first, followed by the offense code (e.g. "Shoplifting: 23C")
26220	Add Evidence to Inventory Configuration	Added a configuration option that, when enabled, will automatically add any Evidence items to the Inventory tab. This option can be enabled under Configuration > Evidence Location Mapping.



Bug Fixes

The following bug fixes were applied in the latest version of eCASE Investigations:

ID	Description
25549	Fixed an issue where inventory item descriptions did not appear correctly after leaving the Description field blank for one item.
25868	Fixed an issue where the Chron Log description was updated with the incorrect data after case conversion.
